

- Please download the Agility Gate app before you arrive at the trial. You will receive a separate email with login details.
- There will be a designated potty area. Please be respectful of the site and clean up after your dog.
- Please keep your dog on a leash or crated at all times.
- No Flexi-leashes will be allowed outside of the search area.
- Ribbons and stickers, except for High-In-Trial, High Combined Division, and New Title Rosettes, will be self-serve.
- There will be a concession stand available (8:00 a.m. 2:00 p.m.). Proceeds benefit the Madison FFA Booster Club.
 - Free exhibitor's breakfast tacos each day.
 - Other items include: Hot coffee; soda; bottled water; nachos, candy, chips
 - Hot lunch options will be available Saturday and Sunday
- Crates and personal items may be left overnight at the owner's discretion. Dogs may not be left overnight.
- Search areas will be indoors and outdoors. Please dress appropriately according to the weather, which is changeable. Please **DO NOT** enter areas that are marked as off limits, including livestock barns.
