- Please download the Agility Gate app before you arrive at the trial. You will receive a separate email with login details.
- There will be a designated potty area. **Please be respectful of the site and clean up after your dog.**
- Please keep your dog on a leash or crated at all times.
- No Flexi-leashes will be allowed outside of the search area.
- Ribbons and stickers, except for High-In-Trial, High Combined Division, and New Title Rosettes, will be self-serve.
- Search areas will be indoors and outdoors. Please dress appropriately according to the weather, which is changeable. Please **DO NOT** enter areas that are marked as off limits.
- We are lucky to be able to use this fabulous venue. According to Ch. 3, Section 32, spectators are encouraged. The Texas Transportation Museum will be closed during the trial, but friends and family are welcome to attend the trial. This is an opportunity to educate spectators to a sport they could participate in with their dog.
- Please be aware that due to the very dry weather conditions stickers and snakes have been seen on the property. We will avoid the sticker area for searches. The museum staff will be mowing search areas. If you walk your dog to outer areas for a "break" please be mindful of where snakes locate to be cool.

Directions to Texas Transportation Museum

Address: 11731 Wetmore Rd, San Antonio, TX 78247

From the North (Austin □ San Antonio)

Start in Austin and get on **I-35 S** toward San Antonio.

Continue south on **I-35** until reaching the exit for **Loop 1604 / US-281** (northeast San Antonio).

From Loop 1604/US-281 head toward **Wetmore Rd**.

Take the **Wetmore Rd exit** and turn **right** (west) onto Wetmore Rd.

Continue west on Wetmore Rd until you reach the intersection with Wurzbach Pkwy. The museum is located just off Wetmore Rd in that area.

Destination: 11731 Wetmore Rd, San Antonio, TX 78247.

From the South (Houston □ San Antonio)

Start in Houston and take **I-10 W** heading toward San Antonio.

Stay on **I-10** west, entering the San Antonio area.

As you approach the city from the east, look for signage for **Loop 410 / US-281 North** (depending on your preferred route).

From US-281 N (or via Loop 410 to US-281) head north to the exit for **Wetmore Rd**.

Exit onto Wetmore Rd and turn **left** (west) onto Wetmore Rd.

Continue west on Wetmore Rd to 11731 Wetmore Rd, San Antonio, TX 78247.

From the West (Kerrville □ San Antonio)

Start in Kerrville and get on **US-290 E** toward Fredericksburg/San Antonio.

Continue on US-290 until it merges/links with **I-10 E** heading toward San Antonio.

Stay on **I-10 E** and enter San Antonio from the west.


As you approach, take the exit to **US-281 N / Loop 1604** toward the northeast part of town.

From US-281 N, take the **Wetmore Rd** exit and turn **right** (east).

Continue on Wetmore Rd to reach the museum at 11731 Wetmore Rd, San Antonio, TX 78247
