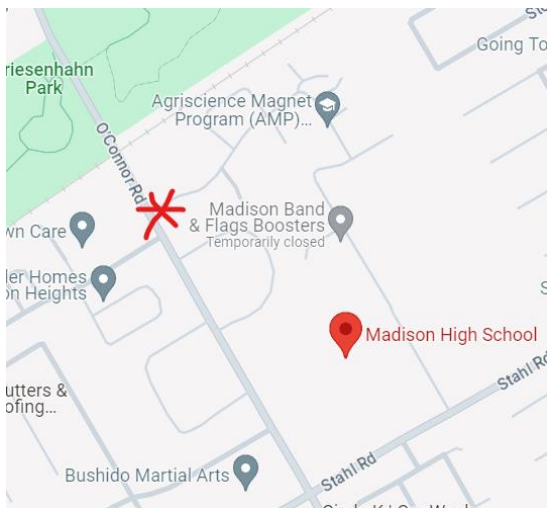

- Please download the Agility Gate app before you arrive at the trial. You will receive a separate email with login details.
- There will be a designated potty area. **Please be respectful of the site and clean up after your dog.**
- Please keep your dog on a leash or crated at all times
- No Flexi-leashes will be allowed outside of the search area.
- Ribbons and stickers, except for High-In-Trial and New Title Rosettes, will be self-serve.
- There will be a **concession stand available**. Proceeds benefit the Madison FFA Booster Club.
  - **Free exhibitor's breakfast tacos each day.**
  - Other items include: Hot coffee and cold brew with oatmilk or half & half; soda; bottled water; nachos, candy, chips
  - Saturday & Sunday lunch: Sausage wraps or hot dog (with or without Chili), drinks, chips and candy
- Crates and personal items may be left over night at the owner's discretion. Dogs may not be left overnight.
- Search areas will be indoors and outdoors. Please dress appropriately according to the weather, which is changeable. Please **DO NOT** enter areas that are marked as off limits, including livestock barns.
- We are lucky to be able to use this fabulous venue. According to Ch. 3, Section 32, spectators are encouraged. There will be signs posted alerting the public that a trial is going on and to please be respectful. This is an opportunity to educate spectators to a sport they could participate in with their dog.
